

#### overview



Printed surveys were distributed to all CVA students, faculty, and staff in April 2003. The response rate was greater than 25% with 51 students and 17 faculty/staff responding to the survey.





I use it to get to my Cultural Anthropology homepage.


Whenever I do research for academic or library resources.


Semi-often, i.e. once or twice a month, mainly library services.

Whenever I'm in the library.


Rarely, for classes.










































## 17. THE LOGO ON THE CURRENT SITE SHOULD BE?
